5:15-6:15pm -Cooperative Game Hour

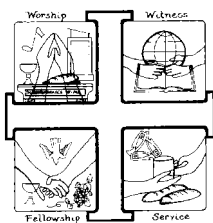

## **Lent 2010—Walk to Jerusalem**

Lent is the 40 days prior to Easter (excluding Sundays) in which we commemorate the wilderness wanderings of Jesus. During those 40 days, scripture tells us that Jesus was tempted and successfully struggled against the powers of evil. Each year, during the 40 days prior to Easter, we remember this time of preparation for ministry through which our Lord journeyed with intentionality, and many of us consider things we will “give up” for Lent in order to enter into the wilderness journey of deprivation with Jesus.

This year, however, the Ministry of Health Workgroup is very excited to invite you into a Lenten Journey in which we include a focus on our health as a spiritual discipline. Scripture tells us that our bodies are to be understood as a temple and invites us to offer our best to God, and we want to invite you to “add something or several things on” instead of necessarily “giving something up”! If we were to walk to Jerusalem, the distance would be 6,875 miles. No one of us alone could walk that far during the season of Lent, but together we can! On Sunday, February 14, we will equip you with several things that will help you be able to “add on” one or more disciplines which we hope will help you to offer your best to God!

### **A “Passport”**

This passport is an invitation into a very specific spiritual journey. There will be daily scripture passages for you to read and meditate upon; a place for you to record the miles you walk (but there will also be calculations estimating the distance of other daily activities as well, so if walking or running isn't your thing, you may find other ways to participate, too); a place for you to write your weekly distances and place a slip in the offering plate so we can compile our combined distances as we go along; some suggestions on healthy eating of fruits and vegetables; and much more!

### **John Houghton Walk On Sunday, March 21 2:00pm**

In honor of a long-time Virginia Baptist Minister, John Houghton, we will walk through the streets of Fredericksburg remembering the work of early Fredericksburg Baptists, as well as stopping to pray for the pastors and ministries of downtown churches! We will conclude with a fellowship meal!

You will have the opportunity to seek sponsors to help fund Alzheimer's Research. More detailed information on this will follow, but mark your calendars and reserve the date!

### **Weekly Updates To Encourage Us!**

On the Ministry of Health bulletin board (located just to the right of the door to the Ladies' Lounge) and in Ferrell Hall, there will be a world map indicating the combined distance our church family has journeyed in the Lenten Season. There will also be information shared about God's creation

that we might encounter along our route, including things like information about CBF missionaries' ministry in different areas of the globe; recipes from various peoples we might meet along our journey; and perhaps the ways that people of those cultures along our way care for their own health. There will also be a stamp to add to your “Passport” each week when you bring it on Sunday and Wednesday!

### **A CD of the New Testament Listen Just 28 minutes a day, and you will hear the Entire New Testament in the 40 days of Lent!**

The Cooperative Baptist Fellowship has partnered with “Faith Comes by Hearing” to help provide the Word of God in every language around the globe. CBF has provided a free MP3 New Testament for everyone in our church who would take it and listen and pray for all the people of the world (literate or not) to be able to have access to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. For our children there are MP3s of Bible stories and songs. How about listening as you walk 28 minutes a day!? We are also invited to make an offering to help provide a translation (or two). It costs \$948 to be able to produce one Audio book of the New Testament in one language, so let's see how many books of the New Testament we can sponsor.

A special offering envelope will be included with your “passport!”
