A Familiar Ministry With a New Name!

Within our congregation we have four registered nurses who have become certified as "Faith Community Nurses". They are Susan Hilldrup, Jane Hipsher, Margaret Ingram and Martie Tuthill. Previously this ministry was known only as "Parish Nursing". In recent years as the practice has grown and been implemented in interfaith settings, the more inclusive term of "Faith Community Nurse" has been devised. Because our congregation here at Fredericksburg Baptist Church has never traditionally used the term "parish" to describe itself and as our congregation has taken on a vibrant outreach attitude with community work, we are choosing to embrace the newer term as more descriptive of our practice.

Ideas about the role of the Faith Community Nurse:

-This perspective embraces the concept that "health" involves the body, mind, and spirit of a person. The congregational setting allows the freedom for openness in sharing/discussing spiritual concerns, as well as the opportunity to know a person over long periods of time.

-The Faith Community Nurse is a resource person. She or he helps others sort through new information about health (such as a new diagnosis), consider possible treatment options, and connect with community resources for follow up care. It may involve attending health appointments with another with the intention and commitment to long time concern and help. In our church and at the Micah Hospitality Center, it involves blood pressure screenings with encouragement and follow up to help an often silent health

risk become "unmasked" and to be addressed.

-The Faith Community Nurse is an educator...helping to maintain a bulletin board and supply of health resource information (near the door to the ladies lounge at FBC).

-Faith Community Nurses, along with staff ministers and the Ministry of Health Workgroup have worked to have AED devices placed at key locations in our church, and to offer training classes for AED usage and CPR, making our church building a more prepared setting should someone experience sudden cardiac arrest.

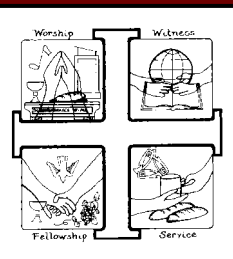
-The Faith Community Nurse is involved in advocacy work related to congregational health needs. An example of this is our past participation in Relay for Life. A group from FBC gathered to walk together, pray together, remember precious friendships, and to celebrate the gift of another day as we focused our efforts in the battle against cancer. We plan to participate again this year. (More information to follow.)

-The Faith Community Nurse is involved in wellness work within the congregation. Watch for more news about a 2010 Lenten option with a "whole person perspective" called Walk to Jerusalem!

-The Faith Community Nurse **does not become involved in hands on care....**such as administering medications, changing dressings, etc., but would work to be sure that these needs were being met for a person through Home Health, Hospice, or family.
