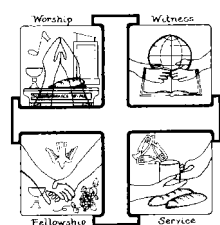

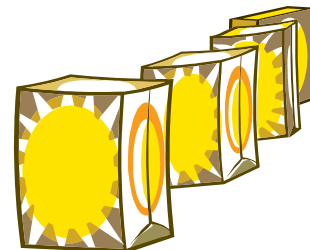

## Susan Snellings to Participate In Kenya Mission Experience

Kutana is a Swahili word which has several meanings including "to meet, encounter, or come upon." It carries with it a reciprocal aspect where both parties are affected. We will meet and encounter Kenya through the people. As a student of Baptist Theological Seminary at Richmond, I will be participating in a mission immersion experience May 6-May 22. We will have the privilege of seeing the work of Sam and Melody Harrell, CBF missionaries in Kenya.

Our professor, Dr. Caleb Oladipo will be leading our group of five students as we participate in Kutana. We will see the work at the Longeiwuan Integrated Child Development Center and participate in a community water survey exercise. We will enjoy worship with Parklands Baptist Church and the Wamaganga ICDC community in Rondo.

In preparation for our trip we have read books, attended a pre-trip five week class and made presentations on the various aspects of life in Kenya.

Personally I am excited about the opportunity to live with Kenyans and be involved in the work of Africa Exchange. I have found from a past mission experience in China, that God graces us with His presence in those we meet and come to love. In preparing spiritually, I

have prayed that God will enable us to listen to Him and love (kependa) those He has allowed us to eat (kula) and to walk (kutembea) with.

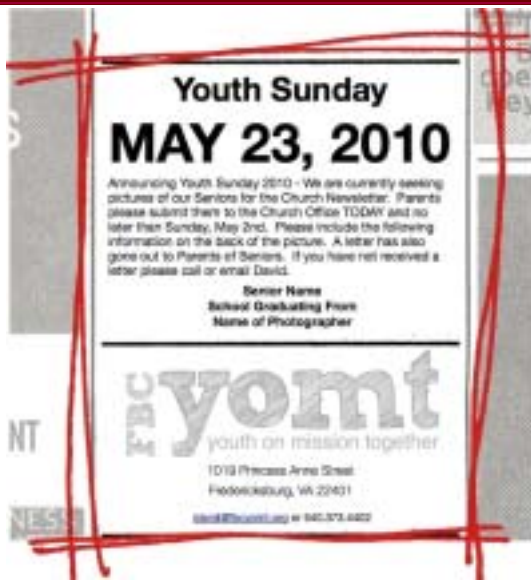
