### **A Status Report On Our Parking Lot Loan**

Our church family was challenged in worship last month by John Fick, Chair of the Stewardship Development Workgroup, to work quickly to pay off the loan on our parking lot. He affirmed the resources available within

our family of faith to settle this matter as well as the faithful giving exhibited by many of the members.



Many of you have heard his message and have risen to the challenge. When the loan was recently renewed the balance remaining was \$314,860. As of the printing of this newsletter the principal balance is now \$281,497, a reduction of \$33,363. This is good progress and thank you to all who are giving to this effort.

However, we must continue to press on towards the final satisfaction of this loan and we must join together, each of us as a member of this church family, to accomplish this task.

Our church history, "Out of Our Hearts," contains many examples from the past of church members working sacrificially to accomplish worthy tasks. Let us honor those who have gone before us by living up to their example of faithfulness and commitment. Let us join together and finish the job.

### **A Look at the Church's Finances Through May Ahead and Behind**

#### **The Ministry Budget**

Our offerings during the month of May this year exceeded those received in May of 2009 by nearly \$13,000 (12.5%). This significant increase has boosted our total offerings so far this year to an almost 3% increase over the same period last year.

We are \$98,918 behind our budget this year compared to being behind by \$111,603 at the same time last year.

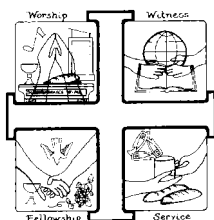
Through May our expenses this year have exceeded our offerings by \$39,372 compared to a deficit of \$29,061 last year and a deficit of \$101,057 in 2008. Although our costs have been greater than last year, they are still much better than prior years. The cost saving strategies implemented over the last two years exhibit continuing benefits.

As we approach the summer, typically a time when offerings drop off, let us commit to consistent faithful giving so that we may continue to have a successful financial year.

#### **Building Upon Our Heritage in Missions**

Our giving to BUOH in Missions trails last year by a little over \$2,000 while our expenses this year have increased significantly. You will want to remember that all of our mission efforts (Thursday Community Meal, ESL, Micah, Benevolence, and cooperative efforts with the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship, Virginia Baptists, and other local ministry partners) are funded through BUOH in Missions. Your gifts to BUOH in Missions are vital to carrying out the mission of our church and are much needed and greatly appreciated.

**Large White Sheets** - we will be making lots of sails with these.

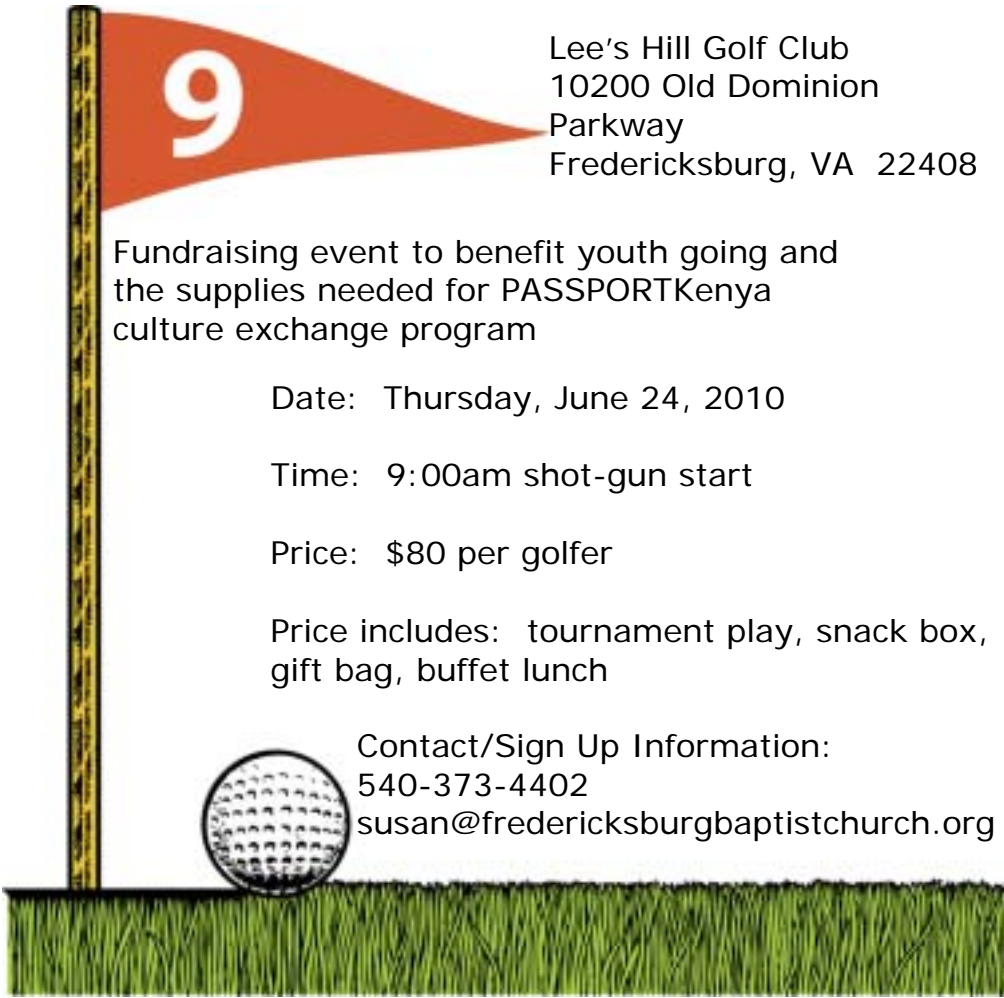
**Ropes** - any size and any width, it takes lots of ropes for a sailing boat.
