Activities for Children; Employment Training for High Schoolers

It's that time of year again for SOKS CAMP at Heritage Park Apartments. For the fourth year, Fredericksburg Baptist will help to initiate seven weeks of summer camp activities at the Heritage Park Community off of Fall Hill Avenue. Children ages 3 through 8th grade will gather each afternoon from 1-3:30pm for lunch, games, learning activities, field trips, art projects, and more! Nearly 10 different churches downtown will host a week to plan activities based around a weekly theme. As a church, we will host the last week of camp, August 8th-12th. Save the date! Capital Project Update

The Property Workgroup planned, and the church endorsed, the completion of two major capital projects for this year: (1) replacement of a 39 year old chiller to provide air conditioning for the Caroline Street Building, and (2) installation of new air conditioning equipment to provide adequate cooling in the Choir Room and adjacent space. Both projects have now been completed. Garnett Refrigeration accomplished both projects and we thank John

Garnett for the fine work his company accomplished.

In 2012, current plans are to repaint the exteriors of all our buildings. Preliminary estimate for this project is \$150,000.

We do not currently have enough funds on hand to cover this cost. Your continued support of our Capital Campaign Fund will allow us over the next few months to accrue the funds necessary to accomplish this project.
