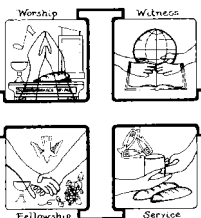

- Painting, coloring, playing, learning, exploring, and more!

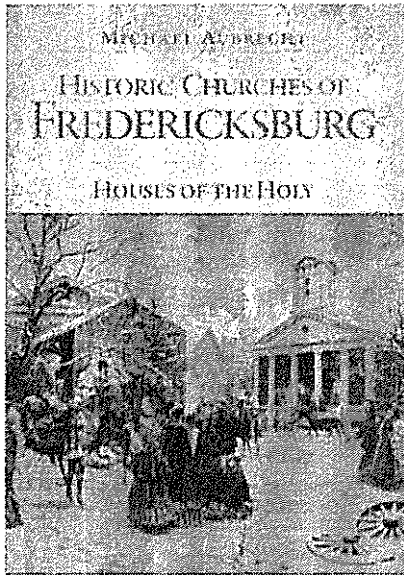

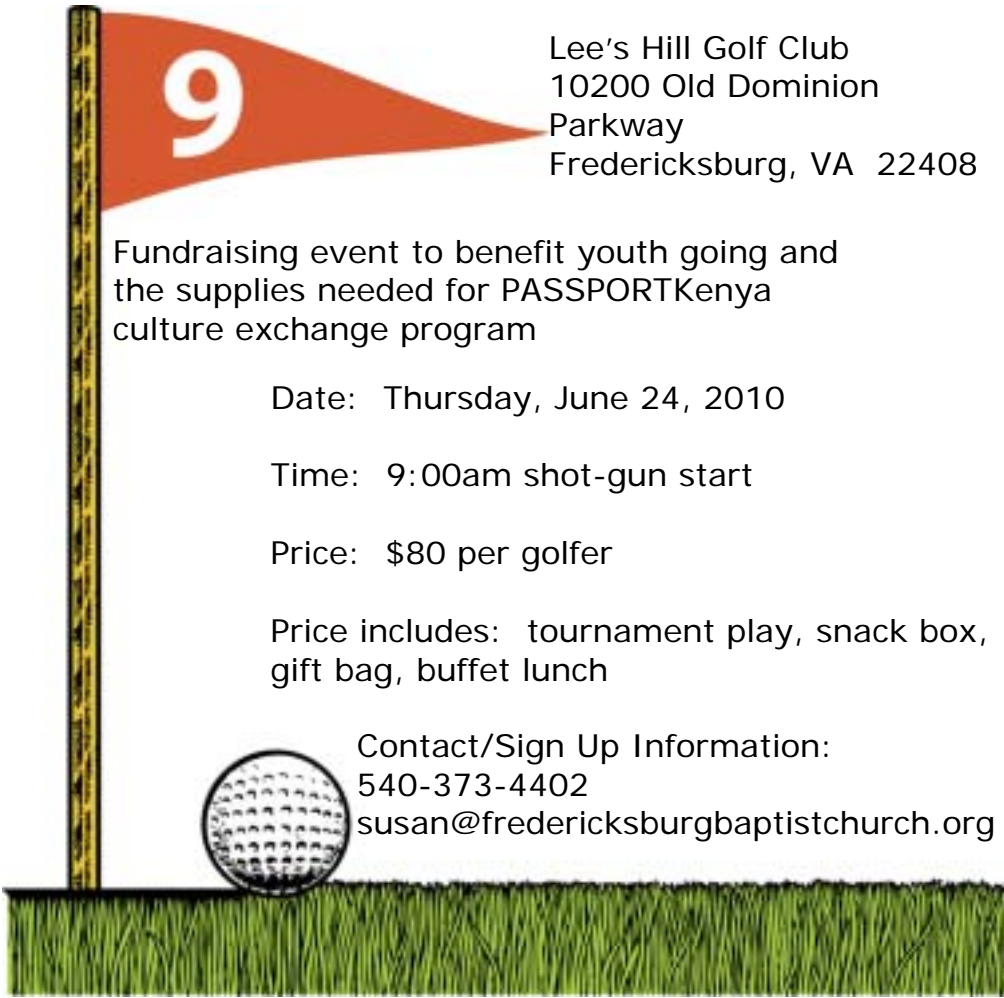


Walk/Run with us!
