Day Trip to The Virginia Baptist Historical Society: Meet James Slatton Author of *W.H. Whitsett: The Man and the Controversy*

James Slatton, former pastor of River Road Church, Baptist in Richmond has authored an excellent book on W.H. Whitsett, a former president of Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, who created a controversy by questioning long held beliefs on the origins of Baptists. On Tuesday, August 18th, we have the opportunity to journey to the Virginia Baptist Historical Society on the campus of the University of Richmond to meet Dr. Slatton and have him share with us about Whitsett and to tell us about the book he has written.

We will leave the church at 9:00am

and travel by church bus to the Society where we will have a chance to see an exhibit on the life of Whitsett and then spend time with Dr. Slatton. At lunch time, we will dine at Heilman Hall, the excellent dining facility on the campus. We should return to the church by 3:00pm.

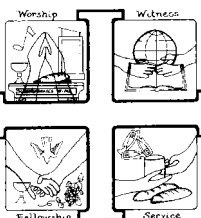
