## Apples, Eyes and Tattoos?

This past Sunday, singing *I Love Thy Kingdom, Lord*, we were able to proclaim our love for God's Kingdom and for the church. We sang the phrase, *Dear as the apple of thine eye, and graven on thy hand*. Many do not connect this phrase with the scriptures, so here is a little background information that may add to your understanding!

The term, *apple of my eye*, refers to something or someone that is very special to you. Some examples of this expression used in the Bible are:

Deuteronomy 32:10 - *In a desert land he found him, in a barren and howling waste. He shielded him and cared for him; he guarded him as the apple of his eye.*

Psalms 17:8 - *Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings.*

Proverbs 7:2 - *Keep my commands and you will live; guard my teachings as the apple of your eye.*

*Graven on thy hand* is also recorded in the scriptures. Isaiah 49:16 refers to the loving care God expressed for Jerusalem, and reads, *A picture of your city is drawn on my hand. You are always in my thoughts!*

This phrase in the hymn gives us the opportunity to express our love for God's kingdom and the Church. It is something very special to us and constantly in our thoughts. The scriptures also remind us of God's love for all.

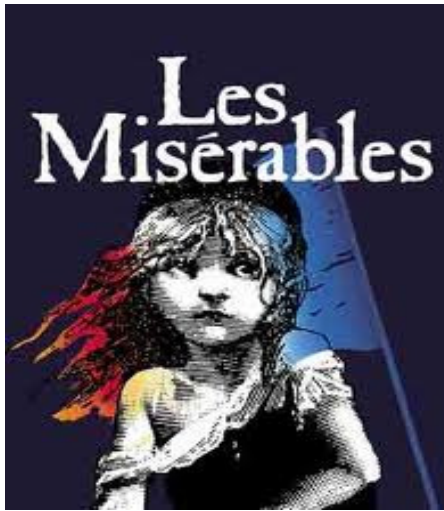
