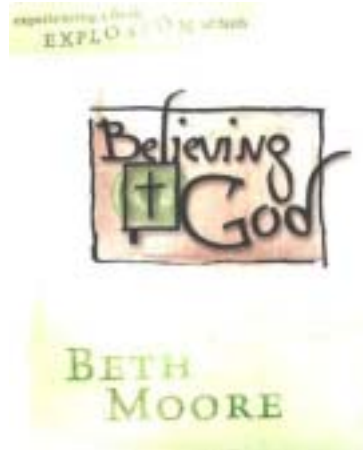

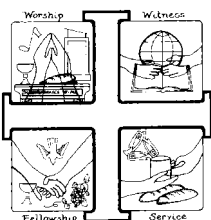
Beginning: Sunday night- October 11th
