End of Year Wrap Up

Thank you to all who have supported the church so generously this past year in your giving. Here is a summary of our 2018 stewardship.

- The Ministry Budget of \$1,366,895 had gifts of \$1,362,549, which means 99.68% of the budget was funded.
- The budget expenses were \$1,357,977. We paid all the Ministry Budget expenses and had \$4,573 left over.
- Gifts to Building Upon Our Heritage in Missions totaled \$89,736, all of which was expended for our various missions efforts.
- Gifts to the Capital Fund totaled \$31, 916. None of these funds needed to be spent, so they will be held for future major repairs. The current balance of the fund is \$119,013.
- Gifts to Watering the Roots totaled \$115,258. The current balance on hand is \$503,196 and the loan balance is \$1,019,301.

eat in the full-service restaurant (1016 Caroline St) between 11am and 2pm on Thursdays or use the ministry to pull off your meeting or event, doing business with the Community Cafe is helping people get jobs and move out of homelessness.

Students work in the program four days a week, and their experience includes a daily empowerment group, serve safe certification, preparing and serving for events that choose to use the space, operating the cafe on Thursdays and working with an employment specialist on the job of getting a job.
