The pastor's first sentence of his sermon was "Lo, I am with you always." My restless daughter said "Oh no. We're going to be here a long time!"

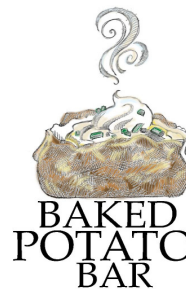
Communion Offering for August
