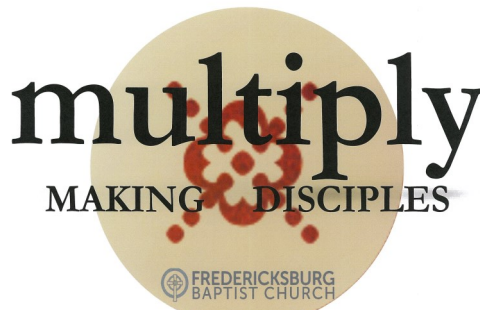

Communion Offering for August

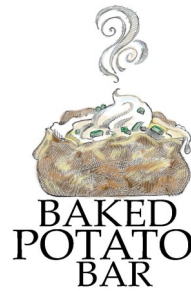
